I'm excited to welcome you now, and I truly can't wait to do it again when you come in through our doors.

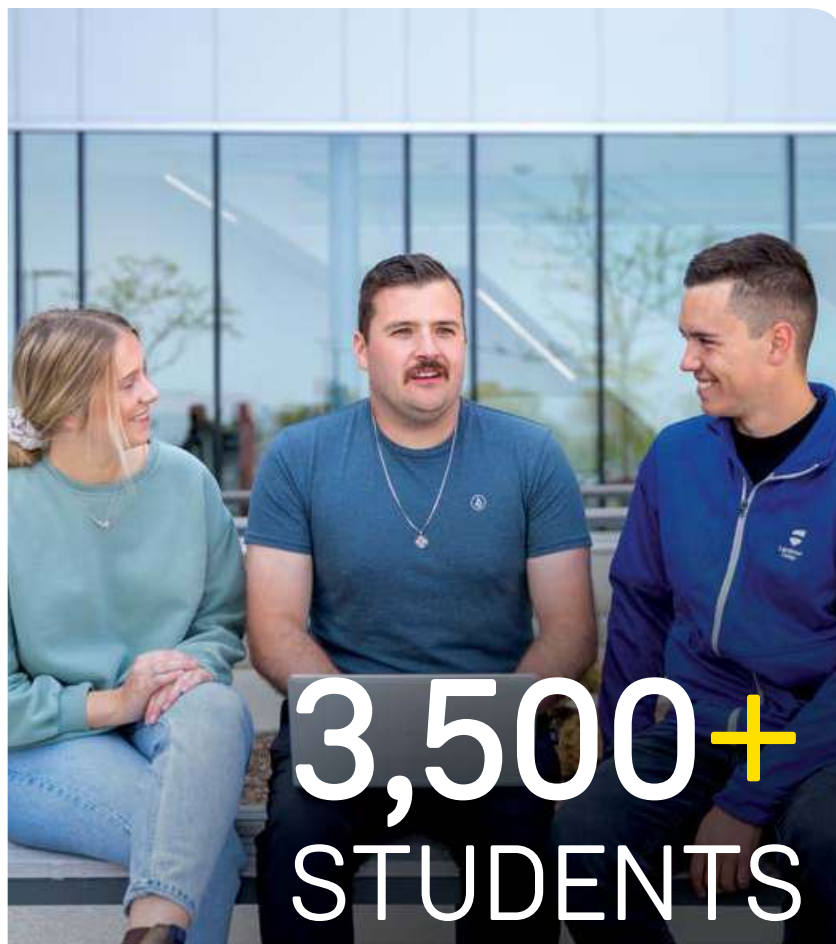

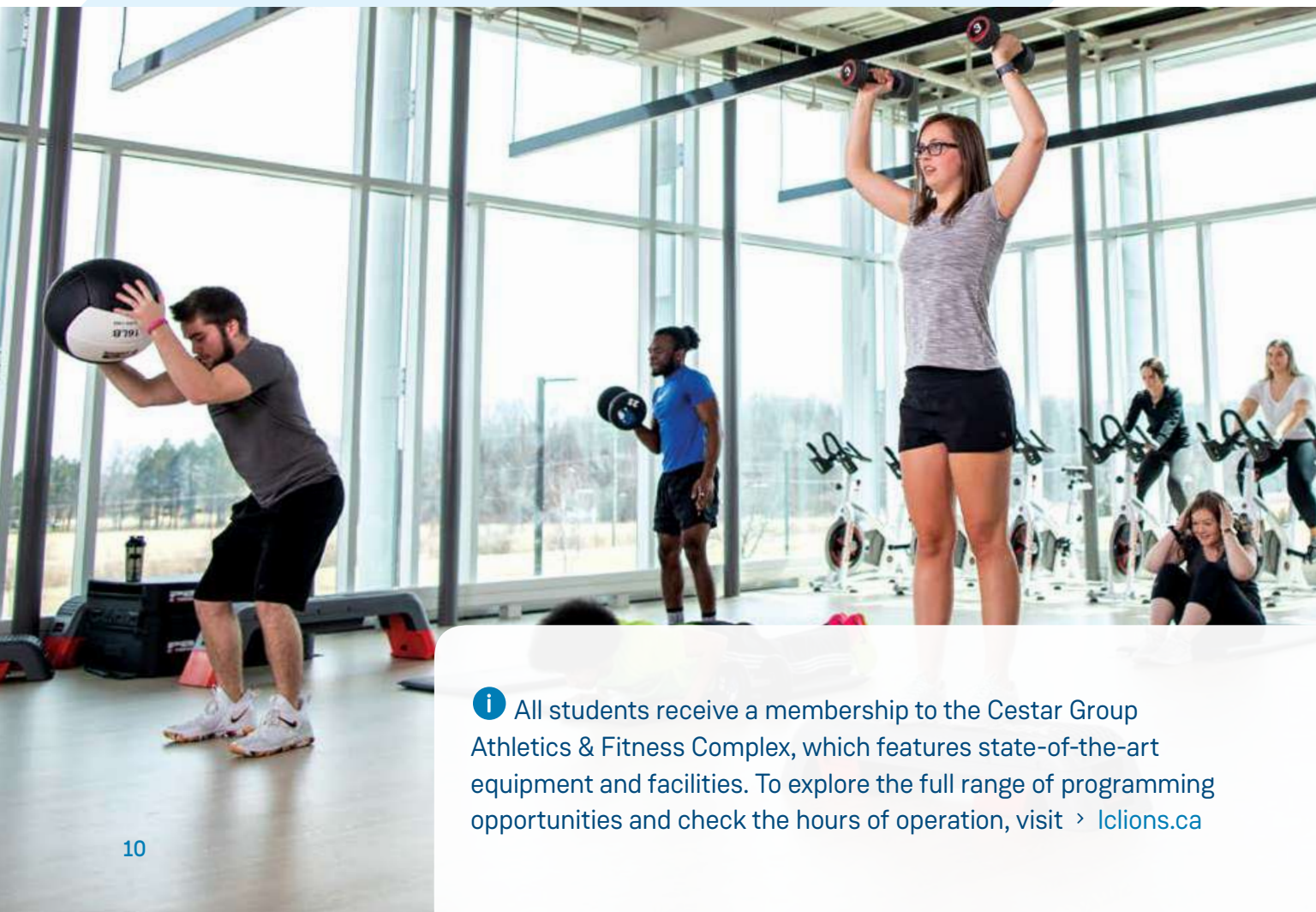

Lion's Mind

Peer-to-peer mental wellness support for students at Lambton College from the first day through graduation. Students can access peer mental wellness training and receive referrals to local social service agencies when necessary.

Lion's Heart

An emergency food bank providing support services for all students in need. Students can also access gently used professional clothing for classroom presentations or workplace interviews, as well as warm winter clothing.

Counselling

Counselling offers invaluable support, providing you a safe and confidential space to guide your mental well-being and academic success. Students can book appointments for personal, academic and career counselling at no charge.

Health Services

The Atkin Family Wellness Centre, located on campus, is available to all students and provides numerous health and wellness services. The centre has an on-staff, full-time Registered Nurse, and hosts two Nurse Practitioners.

Chaplaincy Services

Pathways describe different academic routes you can take to pursue additional credentials while gaining recognition for your prior learning.

Benefits of Pathways?

Save Money

Typically, students who begin their studies at Lambton College and then pursue degree programs using transfer opportunities save money on tuition and living costs by studying at college and possibly living in their hometown.

Increase Opportunity

By completing a college program first, students who use transfer opportunities can complete two programs within the same amount of time as other students may take to complete one degree program. By completing two credentials, you increase opportunities and can be more flexible when looking for work after completing your schooling.

Change Plans

Through transfer opportunities, you can change your mind without repeating courses or backtracking. Transfer to and from Lambton College or just change between two programs to get back on track, learning what you love.

Whether you're considering transferring to Lambton College, switching between programs, or planning your next steps after graduation, we have options that make the transition seamless.

REAL-WORLD LEARNING STARTS HERE

Students at Lambton College — no matter which program they choose — can take what they've learned in class and apply it to real-world situations through co-ops, internships, placements, capstone projects and community partnerships.



Our Pharmacy Technician program consists of a total of 360 placement hours – 200 in a community pharmacy and 160 in a hospital pharmacy.



Honours Bachelor of Science – Nursing students get two, 300-hour clinical practicums in their final year of the program.



Pre-Service Firefighter Education & Training students gain over 250 hours of skills practice and testing in simulated and controlled live fire training scenarios.



Lambton College maintains a strong partnership with Big Brothers Big Sisters of Sarnia-Lambton, providing 15–20 field placements annually for students in Child & Youth Care, Social Service Worker, and Office Administration programs.



School of Business & Sustainability Leadership students complete capstone projects that solve real business challenges for local organizations, giving them hands-on experience and a portfolio of work before graduation.



Sports & Recreation Management students study at the only Ontario college with an Ontario Hockey League arena on campus. Our students benefit from being a part of game-day operations through our Sarnia Sting partnership.



Police Foundations and Border Services students can apply to join the Community Crime Unit, a partnership with Sarnia Police Service. Working alongside a constable, students gain hands-on experience investigating low-level crimes, supporting victims, and helping keep the community safe.

Field Placements that Build Confidence

In the Community Integration through Co-operative Education (CICE) program, students apply their skills in real workplaces. With the support of dedicated job coaches and CICE Learning Specialists, students complete field placements in three of their four terms, gaining hands-on experience in their chosen area of concentration. These personalized placements give students the chance to build confidence, develop job-readiness skills, and explore career paths in supportive environments.

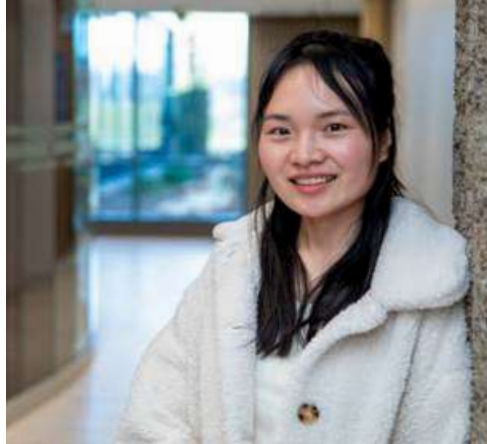
