FAQs

How will theory courses be delivered?

All program theory courses will be delivered online. Most theory courses will be delivered online in a synchronous fashion with real time interaction between faculty and classmates. Others may be a blend of synchronous and asynchronous activities. Each professor will inform the students of their course plan at the beginning of the term.

How will my communications or general education courses be delivered?

The BSCN/BSCP program does not have communications or general elective courses.

What can I expect during the practical lab component of my program?

Experiential labs will be taught in person at the college with strict adherence to infection control practices as laid out by Lambton College and Public health.

How many days will I need to be on campus/clinical agency?

First-year students

Experiential labs (NURS 1521)- one day per week for 3 hours on Wednesday afternoon or Thursday morning or afternoon.

Clinical (NURS 1512) - every other week on Friday at Bluewater Health. For the first few weeks of the term, clinical will take place in the college to prepare students for the hospital. Detailed schedules will be provided to you prior to the start of the term.

Second-year students

Experiential lab (NURS 2541) - once weekly for 2 hours on Monday or Tuesday.

Clinical (NURS 2532) - one day per week on Monday or Tuesday (opposite of lab day) at Bluewater Health.

What additional supplies are recommended for my program? Will I need PPE?

All supplies used in the fall will continue to be required for the winter term. You will need to have **your own** mask, gloves, goggles, and gown depending on the activities taking place in the lab. These will not be supplied by the college. Clinical placements will continue supplying you with a mask for your shift and reusable face shield as well.
