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### FAQs

#### How will theory courses be delivered?

Theory courses will be delivered virtually using D2L with class discussions being facilitated using the Microsoft Teams platform. There is an expectation in most theory courses that you will be attending class virtually for one to two scheduled hours, per course, per week. Course content will be presented in various ways to meet the needs of many learning styles.

#### How will my communications and general education courses be delivered?

These courses will be delivered virtually for the entire winter term.

#### How many days will I need to be on campus?

There are no days required on campus.

#### How has the field placement component of my program been affected?

First-year students will have their placement experience differed to Fall 2021. Online placement modules will be available in the Winter 2021 term to further prepare first-year students for the field. Second and third-year students will be continuing placement based on the agreement made during the Fall 2020 term.
