FAQs

How will theory courses be delivered?

Paramedic Theory courses will be delivered remotely using a combination of recorded and virtual lecture, virtual faculty hours, textbook assignments and assessments.

How will my communications or general education courses be delivered?

Both communications and general education will be delivered in the remote setting.

What can I expect during the practical lab component of my program?

Paramedic labs are to be delivered on campus. All labs will be in small groups adhering to provincial guidelines with a student to faculty ratio of 5:1

How many days will I need to be on campus?

For PARA courses you will be on campus at least one day a week, other days may be required for physical education courses.

How has the clinical part of my program been affected?

Clinical planning is in progress for term 2 with students attending on-site clinical where feasible and in keeping with Provincial Guidelines.

What if I have questions for my faculty?

Faculty in all paramedic courses will be available for office hours either by phone or by video conferencing using Microsoft Teams. Naturally, faculty will also be available by email or through D2L.
