

# Practical Nursing

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## FAQs

### How will theory courses be delivered?

All core program theory courses will be delivered online, in a synchronous fashion with real time interaction with faculty and classmates.

### How will my communications or general education courses be delivered?

All communication and general elective courses will be delivered online.

### What can I expect during the practical lab component of my program?

First-year students will have face to face delivery for Clinical Skills Simulation and Health Assessment lab.

Second year students are not in the lab during the winter semester, with the exception of one day for a simulated clinical experience. This experience will either be completed on campus or done virtually. More information will be provided as the winter semester progresses.

Strict adherence to infection controls practices will be followed in the lab as laid out by Lambton College and Public health guidelines.

### How many days will I need to be on campus?

First-year students – 2 days per week, one day on campus for face to face delivery of Health Assessment lab and Clinical Skills Simulation and one day of clinical placement at assigned clinical agency.

Second-year students - not on campus but 2 days per week of clinical placement at assigned clinical agency.

### How has the clinical part of my program been affected?

Presently with the current pandemic situation, clinical placements have not been affected.

### What additional supplies are recommended for my program? Will I need a new laptop/webcam/microphone?

First-year students will require the semester 2 Practical Nursing lab kit, available for purchase at the Lambton College Campus shop.

Both first and second-year students require a navy-blue uniform, shoes, stethoscope, name tag and uniform arm badge. Information about uniform requirements can be found in the Practical Nursing Program Guide.

All students will need a laptop with webcam and microphone functions
