How will theory courses be delivered?

Theory courses this Winter will be delivered remotely using both asynchronous and synchronous delivery.

How will communications or general education courses be delivered?

Both the communication and the general education courses will be delivered remotely with no need to be on campus.

What can I expect during the practical lab component of my program?

The practical lab component of the PSW program will be on campus in our new nursing labs.

How many days will I need to be on campus?

You will need to be on campus for your practical lab which will be 4 hours per week. As well some of your tests and exam will be written on campus.

How has the clinical part of my program been affected?
