FAQs

How will theory courses be delivered?

All theory courses will be delivered in an online format. Courses may be a combination of online meetings and independent learning activities.

Second-year students will have condensed theory courses that will be offered from September 14 to November 27.

How many days will I need to be on campus?

For Recreation Therapy-specific courses (TRE-1203, HLT-1203, PHR-1093) students are not required to be on campus. Some general education electives may require students to be on campus.

How has the field placement component of my program been affected?

First-year students will go to placement in May 2021 as long as placement agencies are able to safely support students.

Second-year students will do 2 block placements 1) April 12-30 2) May 10-28 (40 hrs/wk).

If students are unable to go to placement, alternatives will be considered (e.g. alternate terms, project to fulfill placement requirements). Faculty will consider the needs of all students in the program before a placement opportunity is initiated.

What additional supplies are recommended for my program? Will I need a new laptop/webcam/microphone?

Students should have access to a device that has both a camera and microphone. A solid WiFi connection is also recommended.
